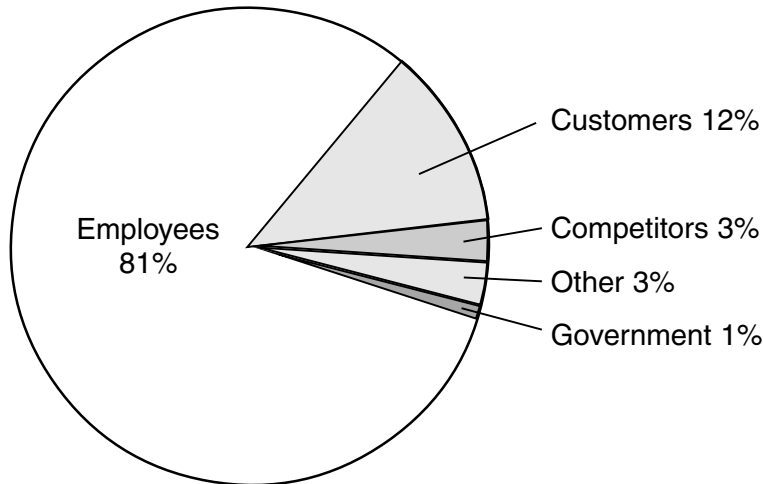

Who Sues a Not-For-Profit Organization? Ironically, non-profit organizations are sued much in the same way as private and public companies. Legal action can be brought by a number of sources. A recent study shows the distribution of frequency by claimant



Recent Judgments The following are examples of claims brought against not-for-profit organizations. Consider the financial impact these situations could have...not only on the entity, but on the personal assets of the directors and officers as well:

- ***\$6.6 Million Verdict*** A non-profit homeless shelter is found guilty of negligence that resulted in a structural fire. As the result of pre-trial agreements, the action was finally settled for \$893,452.
- ***\$75,000 Settlement*** An executive director of a day care center is terminated due to unauthorized spending of funds. The day care center is sued for wrongful termination resulting in a settlement in favor of the former employee.
- ***\$350,358 Plaintiff Award*** A library is sued for wrongful termination by a former employee. The library board cites many negative reviews by supervisors. The plaintiff alleges retaliation for reporting that a supervisor had unlawfully removed library property.
- ***\$125,000 Settlement*** Two employees of a non-profit organization allege sexual harassment by their supervisor.
